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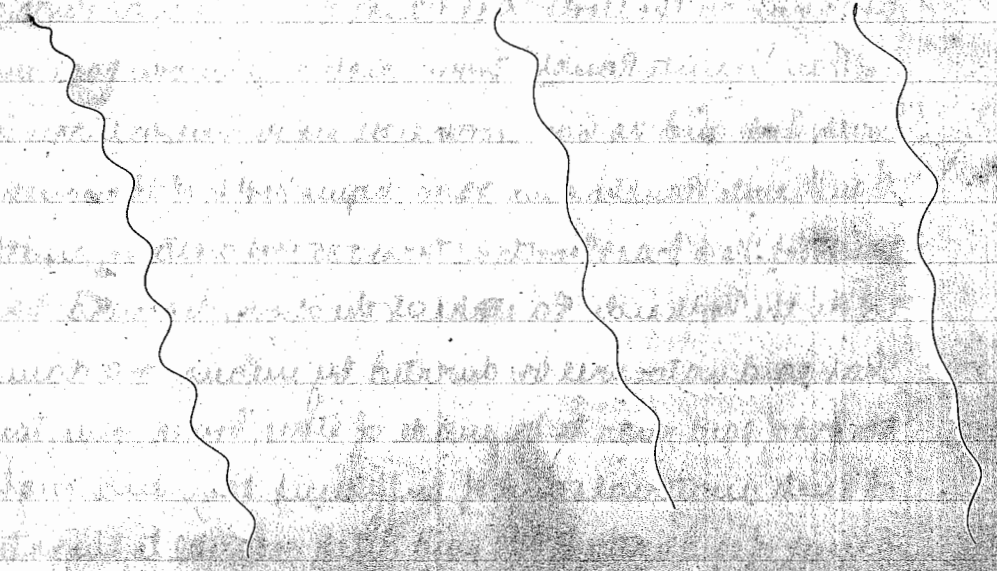
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Notice of Appropriation of Water. Know all men by these presents, - That J. G. Somavia of the County of Monterey State of California, do hereby give notice that I claim the Waters of the Salinas River in said County and State flowing and to flow therein to the extent of 80 inches of Water - thereof, Measured under a four inch pressure for irrigation purposes to irrigate 100 acres of land in said County and State which tract of land is part of Lot 11 of the Malasin partition of the Guadalupe Rancho the said Salinas River running through my said land, the water so appropriated and claimed by me is to be diverted from said river through a six inch pipe by means of a pump at a point 300 yards North of my dairy house, ^{March 11 - 1899} J. G. Somavia State of California County of Monterey ss. J. G. Somavia, being first duly sworn deposes and says; that on the 11th day of March A.D. 1899 he posted the original Notice of appropriation of water, of which the above is a true copy, at the point of diversion above mentioned in a conspicuous place J. Notice of Appropriation of Water. Know all men by these presents: That I, J.G. Somavia of the County of Monterey, State of California, do hereby give notice that I claim the Waters of the Salinas River in said County and state flow(-)ing and to flow therein, to the extent of 80 inches of water thereof, measured under a four inch pressure, for irrigation purposes to irrigate 100 acres of land in said County and state, which tract of land is part of Lot N of the Malarin partition of the Guadelupe Rancho, the said Salinas River running through my said land. The water so appropriated and claimed by me is to be diverted from said river through a six inch pipe, by means of a pump at a point 300 yards North of my dairy house. March 11, 1899. J.G. Somavia, State of California, County of Monterey, ss. J.G. Somavia, being first duly sworn deposes and says that he posted the original notice of appropriation of water, of which the above is a true copy, at the point of diversion above mentioned, in a conspicuous place.
