

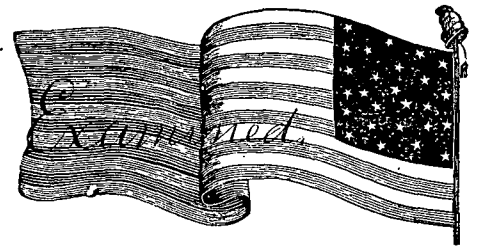

THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, Warrant No. 98,926 for 100 acres, in favor of Manuel Private Captain Jacobs' Company California Volunteers War with Mexico

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the South West quarter of the North West quarter of Section Nine, the South East quarter of the North East quarter of Section Eight and the North East half of the South East quarter of Section Eight in Township Twenty five South of Range Eleven East Mount Diablo Meridian in the District of Lands subject to sale at San Francisco California containing one hundred and sixty acres.

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL. The said Warrant having been assigned by the said Manuel to Nathaniel W. Miller in whose favor said tract has been located.

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Nathaniel W. Miller as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Nathaniel W. Miller as assignee as aforesaid and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
