**MEG CHRISTIAN** is a nationally known singer, songwriter and guitarist. Since 1973 when she gave up a lucrative nightclub career in Washington, D.C. to concentrate on performing music for and by women, she has met with an overwhelming response. Meg graduated from the University of North Carolina with a double degree in English and music; she was the school's first guitar major. She has written and collected a large repertoire of women's music: music that creates an atmosphere that helps women feel positive about themselves, their changes and their growth. Meg is a co-founder of Olivia Records and has released two albums on Olivia, "I Know You Know" and "Face the Music." In 1981, Olivia will release Meg's third album tentatively entitled "Turning It Over." Meg is a warm and delightful performer and Demeter Productions is proud to produce her in concert.

**RIVER** is an all women's band from Santa Cruz who made their debut in Monterey last December. Their music encompasses a variety of styles that each member brings to the group. Cackie Gates plays music ranging from country and western to rock and roll; Vicky Blevins, on dulcimer, has her musical roots primarily in country and gospel music; Jerilyn Munyon's major musical influence is traditional American folk music; Beth Marlis composes and performs electronic music, Javanese Gamelan and jazz. They are working on their first album on the Rising Records label which will be released in the spring of 1981.

**SANDRA FAULKNER** will sign the concert tonight. She learned sign language for both personal and political reasons. There are over 500,000 deaf people in the United States who use sign language as their native language. She came to American Sign Language with a strong background in music and dance. She views it as both a communication skill and as an exciting new art form.
