



Saving Our Environment

- Sam Farr persuaded the President to establish the California Coastal National Monument, securing permanent wilderness protection for thousands of rocks, islands, exposed reefs and pinnacles along the entire California coast.
- He also won the effort to double the size of the Pinnacles National Monument to protect this treasure from urban sprawl.
- He's repeatedly saved the Monterey Bay Marine Sanctuary from threatened funding cuts.
- He's won more than \$20 million to protect the scenery of Big Sur.
- Sam authored the National Oceans Act to promote comprehensive ocean resource management, and brought the first National Oceans Conference to Monterey Bay.




Creating Good Jobs

- Sam has cast the tough votes in Congress to establish fiscal discipline and wipe out the deficit, creating a booming economy and millions of new jobs.
- Here at home he's created 100 new jobs by bringing the Defense Finance and Accounting Service facility to the former Fort Ord.
- He saved the Social Security data center in Salinas, keeping 300 jobs.
- He's won locality pay increases for federal workers in Monterey County to meet the high cost of living.
- He helped prevent shutdown of the Defense Language Institute and the Naval Postgraduate School.







Reforming Health Care

- Sam co-authored the bill to provide Medicare coverage of prescription drugs, and is also working to provide better health coverage for children.
- He's consistently supported increased funding for veterans' health care programs.
- He led the successful effort to establish a new VA clinic at the former Fort Ord.
- He's been a strong advocate for the mentally ill, speaking out, for example, at the recent White House Conference on Mental Health.
- He's worked with the Justice Department to ensure that police are better trained to handle mentally ill suspects.
- He's fought to increase funding for the National Institute of Nursing Research.





Improving Our Schools

- Sam has obtained more than \$61 million to convert the buildings at Fort Ord into CSU Monterey Bay.
- He's brought a new \$25 million science lab to UCSC.
- He helped California get permission to use federal funds to reduce class size in our overcrowded middle schools.
- He's won funding for hundreds of new police to patrol our schools, to help break up gangs and stop senseless violence.
- He strongly promotes the "Peace Builders" program, where students learn to resolve differences.
- He authored legislation for better teacher training in core subjects.
