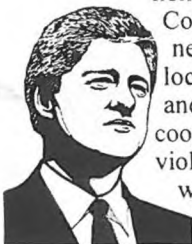


Clinton Visit ¡Viva Salinas!



President Clinton came to the District in September to honor the city of Salinas for its aggressive efforts to combat crime. Sam Farr drove down with the President and Chief of Staff Leon Panetta from San Jose.

The President went out of his way to honor and praise our Congressman, Sam Farr, neighborhood leaders, local officials, and county and city programs for their cooperative effort to combat violence. With the President was the Salinas Police Department's Violence Suppression Unit and Salinas Police Chief Don Nelson



"What I want to ask everyone in America is, 'If your community hasn't done what they've done in Salinas, what's your excuse?'"

Salinas received \$1 million from the federal government for community policing and a new computerized crime data system.

Sam Farr followed, lauding the efforts of organizations like Peace Builders and Barrios Unidos.

Referencing the First Lady's book, and the recent Olympics, Farr stated, "It does take a village to raise a child. There's gold in every child," noting that investments in needy young people can pay off.

Esther Perez & Herb Aarons on the birth of their baby girl, Solisa. She was born Monday, September 2nd - Labor Day!

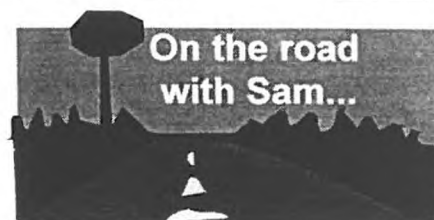
Get Well
