Section 65.5 of the California Agricultural Code requires that the Agricultural Commissioner compile a report covering conditions, acreage, production and value of the agricultural products of his county.

The prices are reported on an F.O.B. basis. Cost of production, harvesting, packing and other handling costs should be deducted to arrive at a true farm value. Where accurate figures are not obtainable, estimates based on information from the best available sources are used to compile this report.

In arriving at these costs consideration should be given to the increased labor costs resulting in a lesser net return to the grower.
