Section 2279 of the California Agricultural Code requires that the Agricultural Commissioner compile a report covering conditions, acreage, production and value of the Agricultural products of his county.

Heavy rains delayed some crops but resulted in an outstanding growing season. The results were somewhat erratic with some crops increasing in value and many decreasing.

The prices reported are on an F.O.B. basis and the figures shown indicate the gross farm value and should not be used to estimate net farm income. Cost of production, harvesting, packing and other handling costs should be deducted to arrive at a true farm value. These costs may in some crops be greater than the gross value and result in a net loss to the farmer.

I wish to express my appreciation to all who have furnished the information necessary to make this report possible.
