Whereas Bradley V. Sargent, of Monterey County, California,

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at San Francisco, California whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Bradley V. Sargent,

according to the provisions of the

Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

and the sections two, three, and four, and the East Half and the North West quarter and the North East quarter of the South West quarter of section five and the South West quarter of the North East quarter and the North East quarter of the North West quarter and the North Half of the North East quarter of section six, in township twenty four north, of Range eleven east, of Mount Diablo meridian, in the district of lands subject to sale at San Francisco, California, containing two thousand six hundred and sixteen acres, and Eighty Six Hundredths of an acre

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said Bradley V. Sargent.

NOW KNOW YE, That the

United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said

Bradley V. Sargent,

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Bradley V. Sargent,

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
