

Special Meeting

Jan 26, 1939

Meeting called to order by Pres. Chester Ogi.

The minutes were read and approved.

Because of the absence of Karon Menda, Pres. Ogi reported on the Presidents Ball Skating Party.

Hal Higashi gave a report on the Public Relation Board, a board which is to create goodwill among the First and Second Generation. At present, they are fighting against the Anti-Alien Fishing Bill.

Jimmy Sabata gave a report on the N.C. District Council to be held at the San Carlos Hotel (Program written in Ex. Board Minutes).

It was decided that non-members were welcomed to register and take part in the days events.

Hal Higashi moved that an amendment be made to the Constitution in Art. II that the Executive Board be composed of the President, 1st & 2nd Vice-Presidents, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, Treasurer, Historian, Publicity Manager, Social Chairman, and two official delegates.

An announcement was made that Mr. Walter Santamora will speak on Feb. 4, at the Japanese Association Hall, regarding the Anti-alien Fishing Bills.
