General Meeting

Meeting called to order by Mrs. Oji
The following guests representing the Monterey
American Legion were introduced: Mr. Irvine,
Mr. Nicholson, and Mr. Jory.

The Obedience of Allegiance was given by the
members.

The minutes of the previous meeting was
dispensed with, due to lack of time.

The report on the benefit show was

It was moved by Masato Suyama
that the report be accepted as reported.
Motion seconded by Otsumi, Manaka and
carried.

that the matter be tabled to the next meeting
and have the lawn committee contact with
the members of the Japanese Association
in the meantime to get their opinion of what
to do. It was seconded by Goro Sota and
the motion was carried.

of July program and asked The J.A.C.A.
to take part in the day's entry. Discussion
