### Executive Meeting.

The meeting was called to order by President James Tabata.

The President gave the new years dance report. Due to the absence of the chairmans the report was incomplete.

A report on the Presidents birthday Party was made.

2. Skating Party made \$11.00 (not final)

The combined proceeds will be turned into the National Infantile Paralysis Fund.

Approximately 38 people including the guest were at the Inaugural Dinner held at Asilomar January 17th. \$14.10 was paid out of the treasury for the dinner.

James Tabata and Masato Sugama represented the Chapter at the meeting which decided to organize a community Council.

Sachi Higuchi gave the treasurer's report. There is a balance of \$80.86 in the treasury. Discussion on dues followed -

1. Notifying people who have signed pledges but have not attended meetings or paid dues, before dropping them off of mailing list.
2. Those who have paid any dues in 1940 be kept on mailing list.
3. Only members in good standing shall be issued membership cards.
4. To get back in good standing old dues must be paid up.
5. Suggested the members pay first three months dues (\$37) before they get their membership cards.

Recommended we have a membership drive between Feb. 15 - Mar. 15th. Suggested that a committee headed by Seizo Kodani approach prospective members and talk over about joining the club.

A recommendation was made we sponsor a benefit movie in April. Suggestion was made to have another movie in September and a Carnival in October or November. ~~There~~ Other ways to raise money were

1. Food auction
2. Cake and cookies sale.

Announced the District Council meeting will be held in Auburn - Feb. 16th.

A suggestion was made that the Chapter give a reception for the Draftee who are on the Peninsula. This tabled until March - but ~~an invitation be sent them~~ the draftees be invited to attend our meetings.
