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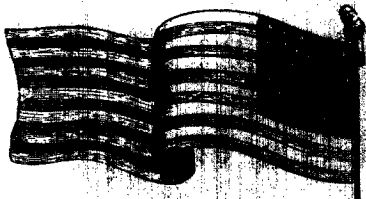

the South West quarter of Section three in Township twenty five South of Range eleven East in the District of Lands subject to sale at San Francisco California containing One Hundred and Sixty acres

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL

the said Warrant having been assigned by Louis R. Ditchey Executor and Jacob C. Hamman Executor of the Last Will and Testament of the said Richard Crocker deceased to John Burke and by him to John A. Patchett in whose favor said tract has been located

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said

John A. Patchett as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said

John A. Patchett as assignee as aforesaid and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
