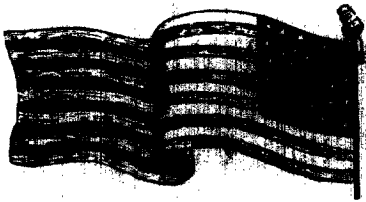

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1865, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE,

Warrant No. 108173 for 160 acres, in favor of Hutch Safford
Widow of Nathan Safford Steamship
U.S. Quarter Master's Department

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon Township twenty five ^{South} of Range seven East in the District of Lands subject to sale at San Francisco California containing One Hundred and Sixty acres the North East quarter of Section fifteen in Nov. of 1872

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL the said Warrant having been assigned by the said Hutch Safford to John Burke and by him to John A. Patchett in whose favor said tract has been located

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said John A. Patchett as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said John A. Patchett as assignee as aforesaid and to his

heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, Ulysses S. Grant
PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.

GIVEN under my hand, at the CITY OF WASHINGTON, the twenty ninth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy and of the INDEPENDENCE OF THE UNITED STATES the ninety fifth
