Whereas Caleb C. White of San Luis Obispo County California

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at San Francisco California whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said

Caleb C. White according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the North half of the South West quarter and the South West quarter of the South West quarter of Section four, and the South East quarter of the South West quarter of Section six, and the North East quarter of the North West quarter of Section seven, and the North East quarter of the South East quarter of Section eight, and the North West quarter of the South West quarter of Section nine, and the South West quarter of the North West quarter of Section eighteen in Township twenty-six South of Range fourteen East, in the district of lands, subject to sale at San Francisco California containing three hundred and twenty-three Acres, and thirty-five hundredths of an Acre.

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said Caleb C. White

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Caleb C. White

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Caleb C. White

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
