according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the **UNITED STATES** unto the said Robert Watt, as Assignee, as aforesaid, and his heirs the tract of Land above described: To have and to hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Robert Watt, as Assignee, as aforesaid, and his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I, W. B. Grant, President of the United States of America, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the **SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE** to be herunto affixed.
