To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas Lytton Rice of Alameda County, California,

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at San Francisco California, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Lytton Rice,

according to the provisions of the

Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

the south east quarter of the north west quarter, and the south west quarter of the south east quarter of section one, and the south east quarter of the south east quarter of section three, and the north west quarter of the north east quarter, and the north east quarter of the south east quarter of section twelve, south west quarter of the north east quarter and the north west quarter of the south east quarter, and the east half of the south west quarter and the south west quarter of the south west quarter of section thirteen, and the west half of the north east quarter and the south east quarter of the south west quarter of section fifteen, and the north half of the north west quarter of section twenty three, and the west half of the south west quarter of section twenty five, and the south east quarter of the north east quarter of section twenty seven, and the north west quarter of the north west quarter of section thirty one in town of twenty eight south of range of second of fourth of the section, in the district of lands subject to sale at San Francisco California containing seven hundred and fifty acres,

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said Lytton Rice,

NOW KNOW YE, That the

United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said

Lytton Rice,

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Lytton Rice,

and to his heirs and assigns forever.

PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made PATENT, and the SEAL of the GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.

GIVEN under my hand, at the CITY OF WASHINGTON, the tenth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy, and of the INDEPENDENCE OF THE UNITED STATES the ninety fourth.
