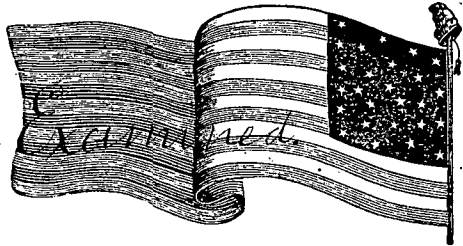

THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, Warrant No. *98,911* for *100* acres, in favor of *George Lendrum* Private Captain Bolings Company California Volunteers California Indian Disturbance

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon *the North West quarter of Section* *Seven in Township Thirty one South of Range Eighteen East Mount* *Diablo Meridian in the District of Lands subject to sale at San Francisco* *California, containing one hundred and sixty acres.*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL *the said Warrant having been assigned by the said* *George Lendrum to Michael O. Jones in whose favor said tract has* *been located.*

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Michael O. Jones as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Michael O. Jones as assignee as aforesaid and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, *Abraham Lincoln*

PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.

GIVEN under my hand, at the CITY OF WASHINGTON, the *fifth* day of *November* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *Sixty two*, and of the INDEPENDENCE OF THE UNITED STATES the *Eighty seventh*.
