"Jimeno Casarin (Manuel)....grantee....of Jimeno rancho, Colusa co. '43. iv 671."....He does not appear as claimant for any of the ranchos granted him. "[BC iv 692]. "Ranchos of northern Cal. granted in 1841-5... Jimeno (Colusa), 11 l., Manuel Jimeno Casarin; T. O. Larkin et al cl." [BC iv 671.]. "Larkin (Thomas Oliver)...though unable to sustain his title to a S. F. grant and the Sta Clara Orchard he was the successful claimant for the Flugge and Jimeno ranchos in the Sac. Valley. v. 671." [BC iv 706-7]. [Apparently, from the records available to this office, Manuel Jimeno, Manuel Jimeno Casarin and M. J. Casarin, were one and the same person. BMS]
