"Felix (Fernando)...grantee of Sanel '44. iv 673." [BC iii 735] / "Ranchos of northern Cal., granted in 1841-5....Sanel(Mendocino), 4 l., 1844, F. Felix, who was cl." [BC iv 673]

The village that grew up around the Felix home was known as Sanel in 1859. Later a new site for a town was established called Hopland, and still later when business was drawn back to the original site, the two were combined as Hopland, known to residents as Old Hopland and New Hopland. [H] [Felix was also grantee of Rancho Novato. BMS]
