"Juárez (Cayetano).....In '45....grantee of Yukaya (Ukiah)...iv 674." [BC iv 696].
"Ranchos of northern Cal., granted in 1841-5....Yokaya (Mendocino), 8 l., 1845, Cayetano Juárez, who was cl." [BC iv 674]. [Bancroft list; this rancho as being one of those that were disallowed, but this is clearly an error as Juárez received a patent in 1867].
[Juárez was also grantee of Tulucay in Napa County. BMS]
