"Estrada (Pedro)...grantee of Asunción in '45. iv 655..."[BC iv 655]. "List of private ranchos granted 1841-5....Asunción (S. Luis Ob.), 1845, Pedro Estrada, who was cl."[BC iv 655]
 Rancho Atascadero and Rancho Asunción became parts of the large Murphy estate, with its headquarters at the last named rancho.[Hoover] The petition of Trifon Garcia and Mariano Bonilla was refused in 1842 because of a house there that was being used as a lodging place by the mission fathers.
