"Vallejo (José de Jesús)...in '40-42 grantee of Arroyo de la Alameda, for which in later years he was the successful claimant. "Ranchos of northern Cal. granted in 1841-5.... Alameda, Arroyo de la (Alam. co).... 4,1., 1842, Jesús Vallejo, who was cl." [BC iv 670]. [The date '40 that Bancroft mentions apparently refers to another rancho of the same name, ~~XXXXXX~~ 1000 varas in size, granted to Vallejo and possibly in Sta Clara. However his claim for this rancho was disallowed. Se BC iii 711. BMS]
