Bidwell (John)...also grantee of the Colusa rancho '45 iv 671." [BC iv 671]. "Ranchos in northern Cal., granted in 1841-5...Colusa (Colusa), 2 L., 1845, John Bidwell; C. D. Semple cl. [BC iv. 671]. "Semple (C. D.)...claimant for Colusa rancho iv 671!" [BC v 715]
Semple purchased this rancho from John Bidwell in 1849 and established the town of Colusa in 1850 [RH]
