"Vallejo (Ignacio). '24...he got a grant of the Bolsa de S. Cayetano, on which his cattle had been for some years. ii 615-16, 664; iii 678." [BC v 756]. "The Bolsa de San Cayetano, 2 sq. l., is said to have been granted to J. J. Vallejo Oct. 25, 1824 [probably meant for 1824]; and a claim founded on a grant to Ignacio Vallejo and Dolores Pico was rejected. Cal. Land Com. Nos. 85, 689; Hoffman's Repts Land Cases. I have the original petition of J. J. Vallejo dated Oct. 27, 1826, in which he asks for two sitios at S. Cayetano, stating that his father had put cattle there 11 years before, and that four years later Don Ignacio and Dolores Pico had asked for the grant and obtained it; but Pico by failing to fulfill the conditions imposed had forfeited his rights, while the petitioner had use for the whole tract.
