"Farwell (Edward Augustus. . .'in '44 got a grant of the Arroyo Chico rancho, Butte Co. iv 670" [BC iii 735]. Williams (James). . . In '52 he was cl. for ranchos in Sta Cruz and the Sacramento valley. iii 677 iv 670." [BC v 775]. "Ranchos in northern Cal., granted in 1841-5. . .Arroyo Chico, Butte Co., 5 l., 1844 Ed. A. Farwell; James Williams et al cl." [BC iv 670]. [Two ranchos are referred to by Bancroft by the Name Arroyo Chico, the one granted to William Dickey and still known as Arroyo Chico and the one now known as Rancho de Farwell. Bancroft and other refer to John Bidwell as having purchased both the Dickey and Farwell Grants. However, this is now strictly true. He did acquire some land of this rancho south of Chico Creek, but not the rancho property. See notes on sheet for "Arroyo Chico" #9. EMS]
