ADDITIONAL DATA (also see back of sheet)

"Leidersdorff (Wm. Alex.)....In '44 he obtained a grant of the Río de los Americanos rancho. iv 673." [BC iv 711]. "Ranchos of northern Cal., in 1841-5....Río de los Americanos (Sac.) 8.1.,1844, Wm A. Leidersdorff; Folsom and Sparks cl." [BC iv 673]. "Folsom (Joseph Libbey)....one of the wealthiest men in Cal., owing large estates in the country, including the American River Rancho on which the town of Folsom now bears his name." [BC iii 742] [The Leidersdorff estate was purchased by Folsom from the heirs, whom Folsom had hunted up with a great deal of trouble. See "The Leidersdorff-Folsom estate" by Robert Ernest Cowen, a copy of which is on file in the CSHA office.EMS]
