Arenas (Luis)... "In '44-5 grantee of Pauba, Los Huecos, Cahuenga, & Sta Clara, iv. 621; v. 561, 665, 627." [BC ii 701] "Ranchos in the S. Diego District in 1841-45.... Pauba, 6 sq leagues granted in 1844-46 to V Moraga (✓) and Luis Arenas; claimant Luis Vignes." [BC iv 621] "Moraga (Vicente)...grantee of Pauba '44. iv 621..."
[From the Drake Index it would appear that this rancho was granted originally in 1844 to Vicente Moraga and again in 1846 to Moraga and Arenas. However according to Bancroft there seems to be some question about Moraga being one of the grantees in the second grant.
