Name "Locoallomi" of Indian origin. Coast Miwok name of a Wappo village. [IC]

ADDITIONAL DATA (See also back of sheet)

"Pope (Wm)...known in Cal. as Julian P.,....In '41 he obtained a grant of the Tocoallomi rancho, named for him Pope Valley, Nap Co..."[BC iv 682]. "Ranchos of northern Cal. granted 1841-5....Locoallome (Napa), 2 l.,1841, Julian Pope; Joseph Pope et al cl."[BC iv 671]/ [In the Pioneer Index the rancho is referred to as Tocoallomi and in the History text it is given the name Locoallome.] "Rainsford (John)...got a Mont. lot in '35...grantee of a Napa rancho by the Sonoma aldalde in '45. Land Com., no. 804. "[BC v 687]. [Rainsford's claim to this rancho was rejected by the land commission. See BC iv 671]. [Apparently an error was made in copying the archives in saying that Micheltoarena made this grant. All sources seem to agree on the date of the grant as being 1841 and Micheltoarena was not governor at the time.BMS]
