"Higuera (José)...grantee of Tularcitos....'21.... ii 664. iii 712-13; Antonia H. et al were cl." [BC iii 784]. The following is a list of the different ranchos granted before 1830...San Francisco District....Tularcitos, to Higuera 1821." [BC ii 664]. "Ranchos in S. Francisco district, including all from Sta Clara Co. northward....Tularcitos (Sta Clara) 1821, José Higuera, who heirs were cl." [BC iii 613] "Rancho Los Tularcitos lay in the northern part of Santa Clara County near the lower end of San Francisco Bay. It extended from the confluence of Calera and Penitencia creeks southerly along the latter stream to the Calaveras road in the town of Milpitas and easterly to include the mountains at the hears of Calera
