"Sta Barbara ranchos of 1841-5Laguna, 1845, Miguel Avila; Octaviano Gutiérrez cl." [BC iv 642]. [Bancroft and the Archives do not agree as to the original grantee of this rancho. However Drake under two separate expediente numbers gives Octaviano Gutierrez as the grantee so it is probably that Bancroft is mistaken on this point. It may have been that Avila had some interest with Gutierrez which G. later acquired. It will take further examination of records not available
