"Hernandez (Juan Maria)...grantee of Ojo de Agua '35. iii 712." [BC iii 782] "Murphy, [Bernard)...son of Martin...claimant for several panchos. iii 712." [BC iv 748]. "Ranchos of San Francisco district, including all from Santa Clara Co. northward...Ojo de Agua de la Coche (Sta Clara), 2 l., 1835, Juan M. Hernandez; B. Murphy cl." [The patentee named in the archives could have been either the father of Bernard Murphy, the son named by Bernard or Bernard Murphy, a brother of Bernard. Bernard might have disposed of his interest or taken the patent in his father's name.] Bernard was killed in 1853, before issuance of the patent. See BC iv 748-9. EMS] [Martin J. C. Murphy was the son of Bernard [H]
