"Lugo (Antonio Maria)...grantee of Chino in '41. iv 634." [BC iv 718]. "Ranchos of Los Angeles district 1841-5....Chino, or Sta Ana del Chino, 5 and 3 l., 1841, 1845, Antonio M. Lugo and Isaac Williams, who were cl." [BC iv 634]. [The way this is stated in Bancroft it would appear that Lugo and Williams were grante Chino together. However the original grant of Santa Ana del Chino was made to Lugo. The patentees were daughters of Williams. Lugo's daughter who married Isaac Williams. Later Isaac Williams received a grant of and addition to the rancho. BMS]. "Williams (Isaac). In '39 he was naturalized, and about this time married Maria de Jesus, daughter of Antonio M. Lugo, becoming the owner of the Chino rancho granted to Lugo in '41, and being himself the grantee of an addition to the rancho in '43. iv 634." [BC v 775]
