"Torre (Gabriel)...in '39 grantee of Zanjones rancho...iii 679." [BC v 750]. "Malarin (Mariano)...sone of Juan...executor of his father's estate, and in that capacity successful claimant for the ranchos of Zanjones, Guadalupe, and Chualar." [BC iv 728]. "Ranchos of Monterey district 1831-40.....Zanjones 1 1/2 l., 1839, Gabriel de la Torre, Mariano Malarin cl." [BC iii 679]. Hoover states that this rancho was granted to Malarin. However this is an error, as the rancho was granted to de la Torre from whom Malarin evidently purchased it. Malarin was also the owner of Chualar rancho and Rancho Guadalupe y Llanitos de los Correos [Hoover]
