"Soto (Casilda)....grantee of La Merced, Los Ang. '44 iv 635." [BC V 728]. "Ranchos of Los Angeles district 1841-5....Merced (old mission)...l l., 1844, Casilda Soto; F. P. F. Temple et al.cl." [BC iv 635]. First Site of mission San Gabriel established in 1771 less than a mile from where Francisco Temple later built his adobe home [R]The adobe and brick homes built by Temple were destroyed by fire. This portion of rancho La Merced remained in the Temple family until very recent years; escaped the grasp of "Lucky Baldwin" [Rensch]
