"Castro (Antonio María)...grantee of Vega del Pájaro '20. ii 664; iii 679." [BC ii 750]

"The following is a list of the different ranchos granted before 1830....Monterey districtPájaro to Castro, 1820." [BC ii 664]. "Ranchos of Monterey district, 1831-40...Vega del Río del Pájaro, 8000 acres, 1820 Ant. M. Castro; J. M. Anzar, cl." [BC iii 678].

[Apparently the petitioner for this patent, Juan Miguel Anzar died before the patent was issued. In fact BC states that nothing is heard of him after '52.]. [The county archives state that the petitioner for the patent was Juan Miguel Anzar, on June 28, 1852, that his heirs were Juan Francisco, Policronio, and Anatolio Anzar, and Frederick A. McDougal, who was the surviving husband of Maria Antonio Castro de Anzar. Maria Antonio Castro de Anzar was, according to BC ii 699, the widow of Juan M. Anzar and daughter of A. M. Castro.]
