"Cole (Thomas)...grantee of lands in Salinas Val. '42-4. iv 656." [BC ii 762]. "List of private ranchos granted 1841-5...Tucho, 250 v. 1842,1844, Thomas Cole, who was cl." [Gregory and Williams were probably either heirs or assignees of the heirs of Thomas Cole, who according to BC died in '58, which was before the patent was granted.EMS]
