"Peña (José)...grantee of Rincon de S. Francisquito '41." [BC iv 771]. "Robles (Secundino) ....one of the claimants of Rincon de San Francisquito. iv 672....Robles(Teodoro).... brother of Secundino, and with him cl. for San Francisquito." [BC V 699]. "Ranchos of northern Cal. granted in 1841-5...Rincon de San Francisquito (Sta Clara), 1841, José Peña; T. and S. Robles cl." [BC iv 672]. Peña received permission to occupy this land in 1822 and received his formal grant in 1841. In 1847 he traded the rancho to Teodoro and Secundino Robles for their interest in a quick silver mine on Almaden Creek [H]
