"Ortega (Ignacio)...from about '10 to '30 was the owner of the S. Isidro rancho in the S. J sé region iii663-4." [BC iv 760]/"The following is a list of the different ranchos granted before 1830...San Francisco district....San Isidro, to Ortega before 1810..." [BC ii 663]/ [Bancroft makes several references to the rancho San Isidro being owned by Ortega in the vicinity of San José. In fact it seems to have been one of the two ranchos clearly mentioned in the annals of the decade ending 1830. However, Bancroft does not clearly indicate what disposal Ignacio Ortega made of the rancho. For further
