ADDITIONAL DATA (See also back of sheet)

"Olivas (Raimundo)...grantee of S. Miguel in '41." [BC iv 758]. "Garrillo (Raimundo)...In '41 grantee of S. Miguel rancho. iv 643." [BC ii 747]. Santa Barbara ranches of 1841 from San Miguel 1 1/2 l., Raimundo Garrillo et al., who were cl. [BC iv 643]. The name of the grantee is not clear in Bancroft. It is probably that Raimundo Garrillo, and Raimundo Olivas were given the rancho together, and that Garrillo disposed of his interest before the Lorenzana before the patent was issued. However, it is possible that the name Garrillo appearing here is a mistake and that Olivas and Lorenzana were the grantees. The first name of "Raimundo" appearing for both Garrillo and Olivas give some credence to this theory. Examination of the Ventura Co. records will be necessary in order to clear up this matter.
