"Tico (Fernando)....purchaser of S. Buen. '45-6. iv 643." [BC v 748]. "Sta Bárbara ranchos of 1841-5....San Buenaventura (mission), 400 v. 1845, Fernando Tico, who was cl." [BC iv 643] [According to Bancroft iv 553, the mission lands were leased to José Arnaz and Narciso Botello on Dec. 5th, 1845. Apparently this one lot was sold to Tico prior to the leasing of the mission or about the same time and was not involved in the lease.]
