ADDITIONAL DATA (See also back of sheet)

First temporary adobe erected in 1797; new church begun in 1808. Today, only folorn-looking mud walls stand in mute desolation beside the roadway. "Governor Arrillaga died at Soledad in 1814 and was buried under the center of the church, and in 1818 the Mission became a refuge for the coast missions during the appearance of the pirate Bouchard.
