ADDITIONAL DATA (See also back of sheet)

"The records of the county assessor of Monterey County show the exact the exact acreage of this grant to have been 29,696 acres. At one time the Pueblo of Monterey employed D. R. Ashley to present its claim for the confirmation of this grant, to the U. S. Land Commissioner. The grant was approved and Ashley presented a bill for the sum of \$991.50. Being without funds to meet this charge the entire 29,696 acres were sold at public auction and bid in by Ashley and David Jacks for the sum of 1002.50, the amount of Ashley's bill and the expenses of the sale, or about 3 1/2 cents per acre. The details of this transaction are matter of record and may be found in the case of the City of Monterey vs. Jacks, 139 Cal. Rep. 542--- C. F. Lacey in Monterey Calif. Herald. 5-2-29.
