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**Have your student attend Saturday School** to make up for missed school days

**V Student's can make up** for missed day's by attending **Saturday school**. Saturday school is a great way to make up for missed days and also help provide your student with the educational class time they **need**.

**V Students who miss school** on a regular basis **are** automatically **at danger** since they have missed critical classroom learning. Students who miss critical classroom time are at an academic disadvantage in comparison to their peers

**V Our belief is "We believe that we can succeed!"**

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**V** Absences can quickly accumulate! **A few days of missed school add up quickly!**

**V Missing 2-3 days** of school every month has a **negative effect** on a student's success!

**V Students** are less likely to be able to read at grade level by the third grade if they miss class starting in kindergarten and first grade. **Older students** are more likely to fail school if they are absent regularly than if they have bad grades or test scores. As these students miss more and more school, they are more likely to **drop out of school and not finish**. Chronic absence from school is also linked to teen drug use and poor health as an adult.

**V Be present** every day!

**Communicate** with your student and their teacher/administrator's

**Contact** the school when you feel your child will miss class
