 "List of private ranchos granted 1841-5...Arroyo Grande or S. Ramon (S. Luis Obispo), 1841  
 Seferino Carlton; Francis Branch, cl."[BC iv 655]  
 Francisco Branch was a son-in-law of Zefarino Carlton. Besides receiving the patent  
 to this ranch, he was original grantee of Santa Manuela, purchased half of Rancho  
 Pismo from Isaac Sparks, purchased rancho Huer Huero and part of Balsa del Chamisal.[Hoover]
