"Rivera (Francisco)...grantee of S. Luis Gonzaga, Mariposa '43. iv. 673." [BC + 696].
"Ranchos of northern Cal. granted 1841-5.... San Luis Gonzaga (Mariposa) [part of this rancho located in Mariposa county until the creation of Merced Co.], 48,821 acres 1843, Francisco Rivera, J. P. Pacheco, Cl." [BC iv 673]. [Without examination of the archives, which are not available to this office at present, it is difficult to say why there is such a discrepancy in regard to grantees. However the Drake index and the archives agree on who the grantees were and it would seem that they are correct. Bancroft is either mistaken in this matter or it may be that Rivera was granted the land and then let it go back or transferred his claim to Medja and Pacheco. Bancroft also refers in BC iv 763 to Francisco Pérez Pacheco, as being a claimant for this
