(Ignacio). '24. . .he got a grant of Bolsa de S. Cayetano, on which his cattle had been for some years. ... "The Bolsa de San Cayetano, 2 sq. I., is said to have been granted to J. J. Vallejo Oct. 25, 1824; and a claim founded on a grant to Ignacio Vallejo and Dolores Pico was rejected. Cal. Land. Com. Nos. 85, 689; Hoffman's Repts Land Cases. I have the original petition of J. J. Vallejo dated Oct. 27, 1828, in which he asks for two sitios at S. Cayetano, stating that his father had put cattle there 11 years before, and that four years later Don Ignacio and Dolores Pico had asked for the granted and obtained it; but Pico by failing to fulfill the conditions imposed has forfeited his rights, while the petitioner had use for the whole tract. Vallejo Doc. H, st. Cal., MS., xxix 161. On Sept. 30, 1830, the disputation confirmed that the grant to Ignacio Vallejo, and, for a small tract, to Pico, in accordance with the regulations of 1828." ... [Ignacio Vallejo died at Monterey in 1831. See Bancroft Ploneer Index BC v 756]. ... The Patent on file in Monterey county states as follows: "... .founded on Mexican grant to the petitioner Made Octo. 13, 1834, by José Figueroa" Bd. f Land Commissioners on Dec. 6, 1853 adjudged the claim valid and decreed that the same be confirmed to him as testamentary executor of the late Don Ignacio Vallejo, deceased." {It is

Ignacio Vallejo and Dolores Pico in 1824; that later, upon petition of J. de J. Vallejo, son of Ignacio the rancho was confirmed to Ignacio Vallejo by the diputation in 1830, with Pico getting a small parcel of land. Whether this parcel to Pico was taken from this rancho ro was other land does not appear in the records consulted. After the death of Ignacio in 1831 the land was evidently regranted to J. de J. Vallejo in 1834 and it is upon this grant that the patent was eventually issued. Since, it states in BC that a claim founded on a grant to Ignacio Vallejo and Dolores Pico was denied, it may be assumed that Pico's daughter and heir, Maria Ant. endeavored to secure this rancho or part of it basing their claim on this original grant. "Pico (José Dolores) ... in '19 a grant of the Bolsa de S. Cavetano rancho ii 615-6....A daughter, Maria Ant., was a claimant for S.
