"Ranchos of northern Cal. granted in 1841-5....Uvas, Sta Clara 3 l., 1842, Lorenzo Pineda; Bern. Murphy cl." [BC iv 674]. [Bernard Murphy was killed in 1853 before the granting of the patent. The patentee was the only son of Bernard [H]ard. BMS]
