"Sánchez (José María)...in '35 was grantee of Llano de Tequisquite rancho. iii 677." [BC v710]
"Ranchos of Monterey district, 1831-40...Llano de Tequisquite 1/2 l., 1835, J. M. Sanchez who was cl." [Rancho was apparently granted to the heirs of José María Sánchez]
"With Thomas O. Larkin, the grantee instituted an early soapmaking enterprise near the northern end of his grant. A rough frame building was erected by them on the edge of Soap (now San Felipe) Lake into which the Tespisquita Slough drains... The Soap works were remunerative until 1848. . ." [H] [Sanchez' children also received the patent to Las Animas rancho in Santa Clara Co. BMS]
