ADDITIONAL DATA (See also back of sheet)

"Suñol (Antonio)...From about '39 he was owner of the rancho S. José del Valle and from about '37 [probably a misprint for '47] of Los Coches, Alameda County [should be Santa Clara Co] ...iv 671." [BC v 738]. "Ranchos of northern Cal., granted in 1841-5....Coches (Santa Clara) 1/2 l., 1844, Roberto; Antonio Suñol et al. cl." [BC iv 671]. "Speciman cases. . .Suñol, Coches, Sta Clara. . .conf. '56 on a grant of '44 to an Ind., Roberto; yet in '50 S. failed to eject an intruder, the Cal. S. c. holding that an Ind. could not make a valid conveyance of land. 1 [Hoff. 110; 1 Cal. 255,] [BC vi 559]."

"This rancho had been given by Governor Micheltorena on March 12, 1844, to Roberto, a Christianized Indian of Misión Santa Clara who had been living on this land with his wife and Children before that date. The question in this case [before the land commission] was con-
