"Castro(Jose)...grantee of S. Justo rancho in '39.[BC ii 751]. "Pacheco (Francisco Perez)... He was claimant for....S. Justo and....becoming one of the wealthiest rancheros of Mont. County." [BC iv 763]

Hoover in writing about Francisco Perez Pacheco, who received patents to Bolsa de San Felipe, Ausaymus de San Felipe, San Luis Gonzaga, and San Justo, writes: "Pacheco became an extensive land owner, eventually having in his possession the San Justo, conveyed to him by José Castro on July 26, 1844. . .The lands passed through the ownership of Máximo Taboas, who sold them on May 14, 1859, to Isadora Pacheco. . .Rancho San Justo, through which runs the San Benito
